The following are the available options from InTouch Credit Union:

- **Classroom Seminars**
 - ITCU will send volunteers to speak to your class/group around a specific financial topic or a set series of topics. Topics will be coordinated with requester.
- **CU@School Days**
 - ITCU will have a table on campus to promote savings, teach students the process of interacting with a teller and banker, quiz students on financial knowledge, and assist parents/teachers in enrolling students in a savings account program (parents and teachers may sign up for the credit union, as well.) **Membership subject to availability, please visit www.itcu.org for more information.*
- **Community/Staff/Team Seminars**
 - These are like the classroom seminars but are geared more towards the life stages, events, and topics that parents, teachers, and adults will encounter. This is a great benefit for staff and PTA members.
- **Reality/Retirement Fairs**
 - Reality Fairs take participants through a month-long journey on budgeting, spending, and saving based on a simulated life. Each life is different, and the participants will have to make choices and see the consequences of those choices and how quickly money is moved and managed. Reality Fairs timing will vary depending on number of participants and available volunteers. **Please note these are limited to 9th grade and up.*
 - Retirement Fairs work like Reality Fairs but are focused on current habits and how those could translate into retirement planning and expenses. Retirement Fair timing will vary depending on number of participants and available volunteers. These are best for ages 25 and up, but open to anyone.
